What you'll find here.

Nice Trader OÜ is the operator of the TechnoTrader brand. This manual is written by me — Aller Uja, founder — for a new client who wants to start with the TechnoTrader signals in the smoothest possible way: typically a 3–4-month test period on a demo account in your own name. Every step is described so you can work through it yourself; the technical side is on me.

IN SUMMARY

Total time investment: up to 15 min for account opening + 15–30 min setup = under an hour and the demo is running.

Demo minimum package: 3 months × €24/month = €72 paid upfront (includes 24% VAT). Can be split into two payments if needed. After 3–4 months on demo, you decide whether to go live via MQL5 — or walk away. If it doesn't work out, you've only spent the hosting cost (€72–88 across the period).

This is a technical setup service — not an investment service, not portfolio management, and not personalised investment advice. Nice Trader OÜ does not hold an Estonian Financial Supervisory Authority (Finantsinspektsioon) licence. All trading decisions and risks remain with you. See section 12 for the full legal status.

Why a demo in your own name.

Algorithmic trading can feel intimidating at first — especially if you've never opened a broker account before. The logic of this manual is built on one principle: **you should feel comfortable before you put real money on the line.** A demo account in your own name has three advantages.

1. Control is yours from day one

The demo account is opened in your name, not in mine or Nice Trader OÜ's. You see everything — every trade, every position, the full account history — under the same platform you'll later use for the live account. The transition to live doesn't require learning anything new; it's the same environment.

2. Demo amount = your real plan

ICTrading lets you choose the demo amount yourself when opening the account. You should use this option deliberately. If your real plan is to start with, say, €2,000, then the demo amount must be exactly €2,000 — not €100,000, which some platforms set by default. Otherwise you can't see how the system actually behaves at your scale.

DEMO AMOUNT	WHAT IT SHOWS
€500	Works with the more active signals (Swing, Active). With smaller capital, the emotional impact of swings is larger — if that's not an issue, even €500 reveals the system's behaviour reliably.
€1,000	Also works with the flagship (Long Term). Sensible balance — large enough to see the system's behaviour; small enough that the starting risk stays reasonable.
€2,000	Optimal balance, especially for the Growth signal — the recommended scale. Gives the system more room to express its natural behaviour across different market conditions.
€5,000+	Suitable if you plan to move closer to live soon. The setup can be calibrated in advance and multiple signals combined.

3. The technical side — handled for you during demo

You don't need to install or configure anything during the demo phase. Once you've sent me the demo account credentials, the system is ready in 15–30 minutes. As founder, I run the same EA configuration — identical for every test-period client — that powers my own MQL5 signals. You watch the result: every trade, every stop-loss, every close, in real time on your own MetaTrader 5 platform.

IN SHORT

On the demo you spend 3-4 months, see the system's behaviour in different market conditions (calm market, volatility, macro news) and then calmly decide whether the move to live via MQL5 subscription is the right step for you. If it isn't, you've only spent the hosting cost (€72-88 across the period).

Two phases — one straight line.

Nice Trader OÜ is the operator. As founder, I (Aller Uja) handle the technical setup during the demo phase, then you transition to MQL5 Signals where you become a self-directed subscriber. The signal logic is identical in both phases — only the hosting arrangement changes.

Phase A — Demo (3-4 months)

What happens: You open a demo account at ICTrading in your own name. You send me the master password (required for the EA to trade on the demo account). I configure and run the EA on dedicated infrastructure near the broker's data centre — the same EA, with the same standard configuration, that runs on every test-period client's demo account.

Why it's safe on demo: No real money is at stake — your demo capital is virtual. ICTrading does not offer deposit or withdrawal functions on demo accounts, so there is physically no "money movement" risk. You can revoke my access at any time by changing the password at ICTrading. In the live phase, I never see your account credentials at all — copy-trading runs through MQL5's platform.

Cost: €24/month hosting only (includes 24% VAT). Setup, EA configuration, and adjustments are included.

Phase B — Live (open-ended)

What happens: Once you decide to go live, you open a funded ICTrading account and subscribe to my TechnoTrader signal directly through MQL5. You connect your own MT4/MT5 terminal to the MQL5 Signal Subscription. From this point onwards, copying happens via MQL5's platform — I never see your live account, and never need its credentials.

What you need: Your MT4/MT5 terminal must stay online 24/5 to receive signals. A VPS or always-on machine is required (covered in section 09).

Cost: ~€30/month MQL5 signal subscription + your VPS (~€25-35/month). Hosting fee from Phase A ends.

Why this structure?

Two reasons.

First — control progression. During demo, the technical setup is handled for you so you can focus on watching how the system behaves. By the time you go live, you've seen 3-4 months of trading, you understand the rhythm, and you're ready to manage your own MQL5 subscription.

Second — clean separation. Once real money is involved, the platform layer (MQL5) sits between us. I publish the signal; you subscribe. There is no operator access to your live account at any point.

This is the standard, transparent way that systematic trading is shared on MQL5 — used by thousands of signal providers globally.

IMPORTANT — WHAT THIS SERVICE IS AND ISN'T

This is a **technical setup service**. The same EA configuration runs identically on every test-period client's demo account — it is not tailored to your individual financial situation, risk tolerance, or investment goals. I do not provide personalised investment advice. You retain full control of the demo account and may withdraw your authorisation at any time by changing the password at ICTrading. See section 12.

Step 1 — Opening the broker account.

The first real technical step. You open a demo account at ICTrading in your own name (or your company's). Takes about 15 minutes.

1.1 Go to ICTrading — use the partner link

~ 2 MIN

Important: always use the partner link — this gives you 25–40% lower commissions (depending on the instrument) compared to standard signup at ICTrading. Over time the difference saves hundreds of euros, and on larger accounts thousands. Applies for the entire lifetime of the account.

Lower commissions depending on instrument (gold, FX pairs, indices), corporate accounts supported, regulated and reliable broker. The same broker that hosts my own live portfolio.

1.2 Choose account type

~ 1 MIN

- **Individual** — simplest option, fastest signup.
- **Corporate** — if you want to trade through your company. ICTrading supports corporate accounts; the application is slightly longer, but I can help you walk through it.

1.3 Fill in the registration form

~ 5-10 MIN

The form asks for standard details — name, address, ID number, contact info. For corporate accounts, also commercial register data (from the Nice Trader OÜ experience: registration number + LEI code if you have one).

The broker may also request a copy of an ID document — this is a standard KYC (Know Your Customer) requirement, the same with any regulated broker.

1.4 Receive the credentials

INSTANT

ICTrading emails you the demo account number, password, and server name. These are the three things I need in the next step to launch the system. Nothing more is required from you.

PRIVACY AND SECURITY

Demo account credentials only give access to **the demo account** — I use them solely to launch the system during the demo phase. The demo capital is virtual, no real money is at stake, and ICTrading does not offer deposit or withdrawal functions on demo accounts. In the live phase, I never need access to your funded account at all — the MQL5 platform handles the copy-trade connection without me ever seeing your account password.

Step 2 — Choosing the demo amount.

This is the most important decision of the whole test period. The wrong demo amount makes the test meaningless — you see trading at the wrong scale and can't compare the result against your real plan.

The rule: demo amount = your real plan

If your intention is to start the live account with €2,000, then the demo amount must be €2,000. Not €10,000, not €100,000. ICTrading lets you choose — don't waste this option.

What's the difference between the signals?

FLAGSHIP

Techno Long Term

Longest live track record (since September 2024). Patient, position-style composition. Suitable for anyone starting out. Works from €1,000. Moderate risk.

BALANCED

Techno Growth

Balanced composition targeting long-term growth without the volatility of faster strategies. Recommended scale €2,000.

ACTIVE

Techno Swing

Multi-day swing composition. Works from €500. More trades than the flagship, same discipline.

AGGRESSIVE

Techno Active

Highest-frequency signal. Works from €500. Larger swings in exchange for more activity.

DARWINEX

Techno SteadyFlow

Low-drawdown multi-strategy composition. Designed for larger accounts — the bridge between retail signal following and institutional-grade allocation.

RECOMMENDATION FOR BEGINNERS

If you're not sure, choose **Techno Long Term**. It's a proven signal that works from €1,000 in capital. Over 3–4 months you'll get a clear picture of the system's behaviour across different market conditions.

Step 3 — Sending the demo credentials.

Once the account is open, you have the credentials in your inbox. Send them to me and the demo setup begins. The most secure channels — Telegram or email.

MASTER PASSWORD — WHY AND WHEN IT'S SAFE

ICTrading issues two passwords: a **master password** (full access — trading, deposits, withdrawals) and an **investor password** (view-only, cannot trade). The EA needs the master password to trade — the investor password does not permit trading.

This is safe during the demo phase for three reasons: **(1)** demo capital is virtual — no real money at stake; **(2)** ICTrading does not offer deposit or withdrawal functions on demo accounts, so the "money movement" risk is physically eliminated; **(3)** you can revoke my access at any time by changing the password at ICTrading — no reason needs to be given.

In the live phase (where a funded account is involved), I never see your account credentials at all — copy-trading runs through MQL5's platform.

How to send

What NOT to do

- Do not use public channels (Facebook Messenger, open forums, etc.) for sending account credentials.
- Do not send credentials over SMS.
- Do not share the master password with anyone other than me (the service provider). After the demo phase ends, change the password at ICTrading to terminate my access permanently.

Pre-send checklist

- Account is opened in your name (not someone else's)
- Demo amount matches your real plan
- Sending the master password (required for the EA to trade on the demo account)
- I understand the demo runs on virtual capital and I can change the password at ICTrading at any time
- Decided on a signal (Long Term / Growth / other)

CLIENT ACKNOWLEDGEMENT — PLEASE CONFIRM BEFORE WE START

By sending me your demo account credentials, you confirm that you understand:

- This is a technical setup service, not an investment service
- Nice Trader OÜ does not hold an Estonian Financial Supervisory Authority licence and does not provide personalised investment advice
- The same EA configuration runs identically on every test-period client's account
- All trading risks remain with you; you can withdraw your authorisation at any time by changing the password at ICTrading
- You can request deletion of your account credentials from my records at any time (GDPR Art. 17)

Step 4 — Demo system setup.

In this step you don't need to do anything. I configure the EA, connect the demo account to the system, and launch the whole machine. The whole process takes 15–30 minutes and you'll get a confirmation when everything is running.

What actually happens

A **Hosting preparation**

Your demo account is connected to my dedicated server, physically located near ICTrading's data centre. This means low latency and minimal slippage. The server runs 24/5, including when your computer is off.

Note: this is a hosting arrangement during the demo phase only. Once you transition to live (Step 6), copy-trading runs through MQL5's platform and my hosting infrastructure is no longer involved with your account.

B **EA installation and standard configuration**

The EA (Expert Advisor) — the trading automation program — is installed with the standard configuration that runs identically on every test-period client. Lot sizes scale automatically to your account size; risk per trade and max-position count are pre-set in the EA. There is no individual calibration based on your personal financial situation — the system behaves the same for every demo client at the same capital level.

C **First launch**

The system goes live and starts monitoring the market. The first trade may open the same evening or within a few days — depending on market conditions. The system doesn't open trades just to "do something"; it waits for its entry signal.

D **Confirmation to you**

I send you a message that the demo account is active. If you'd like, I can also send a screenshot — to confirm that the technical side is up and watching.

What you can do after setup

- Log into your MetaTrader 5 platform — you see every trade in real time, the same as I do.
- View your FXer dashboard (if you connect FXer) — all analytics in one place.
- Nothing else needs to be done — the system trades on its own during the demo phase.

FXER (OPTIONAL BUT RECOMMENDED)

FXer is a trading journal and analytics platform — the same tool I use myself. It gives a much better overview than the broker's standard platform: drawdowns, win rate, profit factor, instrument distribution, etc. First 6 months at 50% off with code **TECHNOTRADER50**.

Step 5 — The test period. What to watch.

3–4 months — that's how long it takes to get an honest picture of the system. A shorter period doesn't capture enough variety in market conditions; longer is unnecessary once the picture is clear.

What to track — and what NOT to track

TRACK	DON'T TRACK
Behaviour across market regimes — how the system responds to volatility, macro news, calm markets	Each individual trade — wins and losses are part of the system, not the metric
Drawdown — the temporary capital decline — how deep at the worst point, how the system recovers	Daily PnL — one day says nothing about the system
Trade count and distribution — does the signal do what it should (Long Term = fewer, Active = more)	"Will a trade open today?" — the system waits for its signal, not for your impatience
Month-over-month comparison — are the patterns consistent	One month's result — could go either way, that's noise

Realistic expectations

1-5% PER MONTH, SUSTAINED OVER YEARS

This is a good result for systematic algorithmic trading. If anyone promises 50%/month, you're looking at a lucky period, fake numbers, or a scammer.

Compounding turns 2-3% per month into large numbers over time — that's the whole point. 30% annual compounded for 5 years gives ~270%.

Losing months — expected

Every systematic strategy hits periods where market conditions don't align with its logic. The system doesn't change behaviour during these periods — no revenge trades, no parameter changes, no manual overrides. Positions are sized to survive drawdowns, and performance is evaluated over a rolling 12-month window — not by individual months.

When to contact me

- **Technical issue** — if MetaTrader 5 says the account is disconnected, let me know.
- **Credentials change** — if ICTrading updates the password or server, let me know.
- **General questions** — anytime. I prefer that you ask if something isn't clear.
- **Performance review** — after 6 weeks we can do a first interim review. Not worth doing earlier.

Step 6 — Transition to live (MQL5).

Once the test period is successfully complete and you're happy with the result, going live is straightforward. The transition moves you from my hosted demo setup to a self-directed MQL5 Signal Subscription — same broker, same signal logic, but now you control the connection.

Transition steps

6.1 Open the live account ~ 15 MIN

On the same ICTrading platform, you open a live account (if you already have a demo, it's just "Open Live Account" — no full new KYC required). Choose the same account type (Standard / Pro) the demo was running under.

6.2 Make a deposit ~ 1-3 DAYS

Deposit by bank transfer or card. The amount = your planned capital. Deposits typically arrive within 1-3 business days; cards often instantly.

6.3 Set up your VPS or always-on machine ~ 30 MIN

MQL5 Signal Subscription requires your MT4/MT5 terminal to stay online 24/5 to copy trades. A VPS (Virtual Private Server) near the broker's data centre is the standard solution — minimal slippage, reliable uptime, low latency. An always-on home machine works too, but a VPS is recommended.

The same VPS provider I use for my own strategies. Co-located near broker data centres. Reliable uptime, minimal slippage, built for 24/5 automated execution.

6.4 Subscribe to the TechnoTrader signal on MQL5 ~ 10 MIN

From your MT4/MT5 terminal (running on your VPS), navigate to the Signals tab and search for "Techno Long Term" (or whichever signal you've decided on). Subscribe directly through MQL5 — payment, copy-trade settings, and risk parameters are all managed by you on the MQL5 platform. From this moment onwards, I do not need any access to your live account; the copy-trade connection runs entirely through MQL5's infrastructure.

All TechnoTrader signals listed under my MQL5 seller profile. Each signal page has its own minimum capital requirement, monthly subscription fee, and full live history.

6.5 Close the demo (optional)

~ 2 MIN

You can leave the demo running on the side — some clients like to keep it as a "control account" to compare numbers. Others close it immediately. Your call. The hosting arrangement on demo ends here. It's also recommended to change the demo master password at ICTrading to permanently terminate my access.

Does the system behave differently on live?

Short answer: no, not meaningfully. Longer answer:

- **Spreads** are essentially identical between demo and live at ICTrading — one of the reasons I recommend this broker.
- **Slippage** may be a fraction of a second different on live, especially during macro news — this is part of real markets and the system is designed for it.
- **Liquidity** — in gold, major forex pairs and indices we trade, liquidity is always sufficient.

What if it doesn't work out?

The decision is always yours. If after 3-4 months you decide this isn't for you — you close the demo, don't open a live account, and you've only spent the hosting cost (€72-88). Either way, we part on good terms and can always reconnect later.

REFERRAL PROGRAM — TECHNO2026

If you know someone this might interest — friend, colleague, peer — both you and the new client get one month of hosting free (€24 off each). The new person just mentions code **TECHNO2026** or "Referred by [your name]" when reaching out. Valid for all new clients through the end of 2026.

The full cost breakdown.

Transparency is foundational to the project, and that includes costs. Here's everything you'll pay during the test period and live period — and every discount currently available through partners.

Test-period costs (Phase A)

PAYMENT — FLEXIBLE

The demo minimum package (3 months) costs €72 and is typically paid upfront in one payment. If that doesn't work right now, it can also be split into two payments — for example €36 at the start and €36 mid-way. We just agree on it in advance. The 4-month period works the same way.

PRICE COMPARISON — LESS THAN HALF THE LIVE SUBSCRIPTION

The monthly fee of €24 includes Estonian VAT (24%). For comparison, the MQL5 live subscription costs EU customers approximately €48/month including VAT — the demo testing period is less than half of that. The price is fixed, regardless of any future MQL5 listing price increases.

WHAT "HOSTING" MEANS IN PHASE A

During the demo phase, "hosting" means the entire technical layer (server, EA, connections) is on me — you don't install or monitor anything. Unlike a VPS rental, you don't have access to the server itself; that's part of the service logic. Once you go live, this changes — you operate your own VPS and your own MQL5 subscription.

What's NOT charged

- **No performance fee** — I don't take a percentage of your profits. The fee is hosting-based, fixed.
- **No refund if you lose money** — the risk is always yours. This is a technical setup service, not an investment service.
- **No hidden costs** — every cost is in this table. If anything changes, I always notify in advance.

The four **non-negotiable** rules.

This is the heart of the TechnoTrader system. These four rules don't change — not in volatile markets, not when a loss looks small, not when "the market seems about to turn around". The rules are coded into the system, not held in my mind.

— 01

Rules-based by design

Every entry, exit and position size is defined in code before a single trade is taken. There is no room for emotion, narrative or discretion during market hours. The system behaves the same regardless of how the day is going.

— 02

Fully automated execution

Strategies run 24/5 on dedicated low-latency infrastructure near the broker's data centre. Signals are generated, orders are placed, and risk is managed without human intervention. On the subscriber side (live, Phase B), copying signals requires the MT4/MT5 terminal to stay online continuously — a VPS or always-on machine is required.

— 03

Risk-managed at position level

Every position carries a predefined stop and risk allocation. No averaging down into losses. No widening stops. Drawdown is a design parameter, not an outcome. Risk per trade is fixed as a percentage of equity — typically 1–4% depending on the signal — and hard-coded into every system. No position can risk more than the model allows.

— 04

Long-term horizon

Systems are measured across years and regimes — not weeks or campaigns. Consistency through bull, bear and range conditions is the only meaningful benchmark.

Three things we NEVER do

No martingale

We never increase position size after a loss. Doubling down after a loss is how retail traders explode accounts.

No grid trading

No stacking orders against the trend, no hidden exposure, no "recovery" systems quietly building unbounded drawdown. Every position has a stop.

No gambling

No revenge trades, no leverage maximization, no "big ideas" executed outside the system. Every signal has been defined, tested and approved in advance.

IN SHORT

The system behaves identically across every trade — fixed rules, fixed risk, no experimental "recovery". **Capital preservation is the first objective. Compounding is the second. Everything else is noise.**

The most common questions.

Who holds the funds and controls the account?

You do. The broker account is opened in your name, funds are held by the regulated broker (not by Nice Trader OÜ), and you keep full deposit and withdrawal rights at all times. I never take custody of client funds. My role during the demo phase is limited to running the standard EA configuration on your demo account; in the live phase, the MQL5 platform handles the copy-trade connection without me ever seeing your live account.

Can I open the account in my company's name?

Yes. ICTrading supports corporate accounts. The application is slightly longer than the personal one, but I can help you walk through it. Estonian limited companies (OÜ) work smoothly.

Do I need a VPS?

During the demo phase (Phase A): no — I host the EA on my dedicated infrastructure. You don't need to install or run anything; you only watch the result on your MetaTrader 5.

During the live phase (Phase B): yes. MQL5 Signal Subscription requires your MT4/MT5 terminal to stay online 24/5 to copy trades. A VPS is the standard solution — covered in section 09.

How are losing months handled?

They're expected. Every systematic strategy has periods where market conditions don't align with its logic. The system doesn't change behaviour during these periods — no revenge trades, no parameter changes, no manual overrides. Position sizing is built to survive drawdowns, and performance is evaluated over a rolling 12-month window.

What's the minimum account size?

Depends on the signal: **Techno Long Term** (flagship) — from €1,000. **Techno Growth** — recommended €2,000. **Techno Swing and Active** — work from €500. **Techno SteadyFlow** — designed for larger accounts. Each signal's MQL5 profile page lists the precise minimum.

Do past results predict future performance?

No. Past performance is not indicative of future results. A long live track record across multiple market regimes suggests the system is robust, but any algorithmic strategy can underperform — or fail entirely — if market structure changes beyond its operating range. Only trade with capital you can afford to lose.

Can I close or modify trades during the test period?

Technically yes, since the demo account is in your name and you can log in at ICTrading yourself. But this defeats the test. The system is designed so each trade is part of a longer strategy — manual intervention skews the results and you no longer see how the system actually behaves. If something seems off, write to me first.

Can I switch signals during the test period?

We can discuss it. Technically possible (e.g. switching from Long Term to Growth), but it effectively resets the test period — we have to start counting from "0" again, and the data collected on the previous signal becomes a partial picture.

What happens if ICTrading goes bankrupt?

ICTrading is a regulated broker. Regulated brokers keep client funds segregated from the firm's own assets — meaning even if the broker fails, your money is protected up to a certain limit (depending on the regulatory jurisdiction). That risk does still exist in principle, which is one reason we chose ICTrading — long and stable history.

What's the minimum test period?

I recommend 3 months as the absolute minimum, 4 months is better. A shorter period doesn't capture enough variety in market conditions. Some clients stay 6 months on the demo before going live — that's also entirely sensible.

Can I withdraw my authorisation during the demo phase?

Yes, at any time. You are the account holder at ICTrading and can change the password yourself at any moment. To stop the demo: notify me via Telegram or email, and I'll disconnect the EA from your account immediately. You can also change the master password yourself in ICTrading at any time — this instantly cuts off my access, even if I haven't yet shut down the EA. No reason needs to be given. I recommend changing the password after the demo phase ends in any case, so no old password copy remains in my system.

Trading should be boring. That's the point.

If this manual made the picture clearer and you're ready to start, the next step is simple — get in touch through any channel. Before that, please read the legal section below.

- **Independent review.** If you'd like to study the system's public history before deciding, all the statistics are on MQL5 and FXer. Everything is third-party verified.
